

Company Financial Analysis Project - 55 Points

Instructions: Your task is to perform a financial analysis on the two companies your group was assigned. Use a presentation method of your choice (PowerPoint, Prezi, or Google Docs), to present your analysis.

Note: Good resources to use for this project are company websites and annual reports.

Things to include in your presentation are:

1. Background of each company.
2. Explanation of how the companies are related.
3. Breakdown of each financial statement:
 - a. Balance Sheet (Compare/contrast each part: assets, liabilities, owner's equity)
 - b. Income Statement (Which of your companies has higher total revenue? Expenses? Net Income/Loss? Explain why.)
 - c. Statement of Cash Flows (How much incoming/outgoing for each company)
4. Which of your companies would your group invest in? Why?
5. Provides links to your resources.

Income Statement Analysis (*2 = 10 pts)	Analysis includes all parts of the income statement for each company.	Analysis missing 1 part of the income statement for one or both companies.	Analysis missing 2 or more parts of the income statement for one or both companies.
Statement of Cash Flows Analysis (*2 = 10 pts)	Analysis includes incoming/outgoing cash for each company.	Analysis missing incoming or outgoing cash for one or both companies.	Analysis missing incoming and outgoing cash for one or both companies.
Investment Recommendation	Provides a complete investment recommendation based on facts.	Provides a recommendation, but does not reflect facts.	Provides a vague recommendation.
Professionalism	Project reflects neatness and effort. 3 images/charts included.	Project reflects some effort. 1-2 images/charts included.	Project lacks effort/neatness. No images/charts included.
Grammar and Mechanics	No errors in spelling, punctuation, or capitalization.	There are 1-3 errors in spelling, punctuation, or capitalization.	Contains more than 3 errors in spelling, punctuation, or capitalization.
