Creative Cheat Sheet



Keyword First

Wherever possible, place your keyword prominently in the top line of the creative. This helps users immediately identify your ad as relevant to their search.

Create tight ad groups of closely related keywords

tennis equipment tennis gear cheap tennis equipment tennis stuff

Also, beware of potential editorial violations when keywords are being dynamically inserted.

Keep it Concise

Short sentences and simple language work best. Double-check spelling and grammar.

What's the Benefit?

Make sure your creative answers these important questions:

- Why should a Google user click through to your site?
- What makes your site useful and relevant?
- How is it better or different from the competition?

Include a Call to Action

Make sure your creative offers a strong call to action. What do you want the Google user to do? **Examples:** Apply Online, Shop Here, View a Demo, Sign Up Now.

Test

Include 2 or 3 different creatives for each ad group, so that you have concrete data to determine which messaging or offer gets the best user response. Our ad server will automatically favor the best-performing version.
